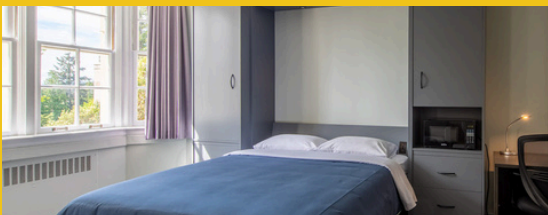

On-campus Dormitory



SINGLE DORM ROOM WITH
SHARED BATHROOM

2 weeks (13 nights): \$825

Includes: single bed, linens, desk, lamp, closet, in-room sink, shared lounge with TV, shared kitchenette with fridge, toaster, kettle and all applicable taxes.

Meals not included. Habitat Café (on campus) serves breakfast, lunch, snacks and drinks which can be purchased with cash, debit or credit card. A pre-paid Value Card offers 10% off.

Off-campus Homestay



SINGLE ROOM & MEALS IN
LOCAL HOST'S HOME

2 weeks (13 nights): \$1,055

Includes: private room, three meals per day and an opportunity to interact with local hosts.

Typical meals include self-serve breakfast, bagged lunch and home-cooked meal for dinner. Snacks and drinks will also be provided.

Arrival & Departure Services

Leadership Academy participants may arrive by flight to Victoria International Airport (YYJ) or via BC Ferry from Vancouver (Tsawwassen) to Victoria (Swartz Bay).

Arrival and departure transfers must be arranged privately; service is not included in the Academy Fee.

Dormitory guests: Yellow Cab taxi service may be used from YYJ or Swartz Bay. Alternatively, several limousine companies offer student groups a friendly shuttle service from YYJ.

Homestay guests: May request transfer services for a fee through the homestay provider, or use taxi.
